Our Facebook page is merely a compliment to that end and in no way was ever intended to replace it. When submitting information for possible posting to either the website or, on occasion, Facebook please allow a two week lead time. Please be mindful that the Chamber has dozens of members and hundreds of friends and the "voice" of the Chamber needs to spread out fairly among all with no individual or group dominating the "conversation".
